

**Petition for a Public Hearing
Anti-Sweatshop Legislation Enforcement - Pittsburgh, PA**

On October 16, 1997 – Pittsburgh City Council adopted legislation stating that working people here and around the world should have a safe work place and reasonable compensation and the same basic rights we expect for workers here in Pittsburgh.

The Pittsburgh Anti Sweatshop Community Alliance has reviewed the City's Purchasing Departments' records of apparel contracts. Without the required Full Public Disclosure of factory locations and without any adequate means of reviewing worker testimony from the factories that sew our apparel Pittsburgh is now out of compliance with sweatshop ordinance, No. 32, Section 161.02 of the Pittsburgh Code.

We, the undersigned, respectfully request a Public Hearing before City Council regarding our 1997 City of Pittsburgh Sweatshop Ordinance.
